Queen Elizabeth I was born in 1533.

Queen Elisabeth I reigned from 1558 – 1603. At this point, people believed that women had no rights to the throne.

Before Elizabeth I, her older sister Mary was a very harsh queen. Elizabeth I was a much more tolerant queen who sought peace and fairness for everyone. As a result, Queen Elizabeth's reign is looked upon as a very successful period where men discovered new lands and set up new colonies oversea.

Queen Elizabeth I did not marry and she did not have any children.

Queen Elizabeth died in 1603.

Queen Victoria was born in 1819.

Queen Victoria reigned from 1837 – 1901. She reigned for 63 years. Her coronation was in 1837 when she was only 18 years old.

In 1840, Queen Victoria married Prince Albert. Between 1841 and 1857, Queen Victoria and Prince Albert had 9 children. In 1861, Prince Albert died. After this happened, Queen Victoria only even wore black.

During Queen Victoria's reign, the British empire was the biggest in the world and ruled over a quarter of the world's population.

Queen Victoria died in 1901 when she was 81 years old.

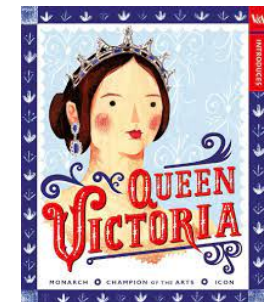

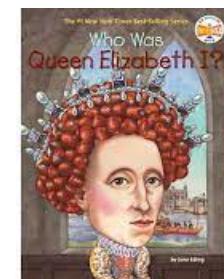
